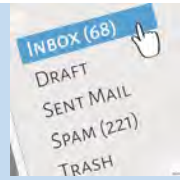

We were praying about what to give. Then we saw the video and it clicked. Those before us gave of their retirement. So we were happy to think about part of our future, our retirement, as a gift to the church.

My father initially was thinking about a \$500 gift. But after the video and praying about it, he declared he was giving \$10,000. I was so surprised and happy. And he hasn't looked back; he is so thrilled he went with that sacrificial gift.

This was the most well organized and positive appeal I've ever seen. I've been involved in many in the area and they can build up or divide a community. This one clearly has built up the parish. Kudos to you and your leadership team.

This appeal has been a reconnection to the church and the parish for me. It was a real challenge to step forward and be part of the future. Thank you for the invitation.

We prayed very hard about what to give. We committed an amount that scared us. Just a couple days later, we were contacted about a closed bank account we had totally forgotten about, which contained funds close to what we committed.

We pledged a very challenging amount of money. As we sorted through our finances, we found a donation we were already giving to the parish we forgot about. It was a message that God will take care of generosity so that we are okay.

Our pledge will be difficult if my husband is laid off. However, I will find a way to still make it work, even if that means taking on additional work. It is our desire to be generous.

It's very simple; this is our future. It is the future for our children and I have no idea why we wouldn't give as much as we can. People before us did that for us.
