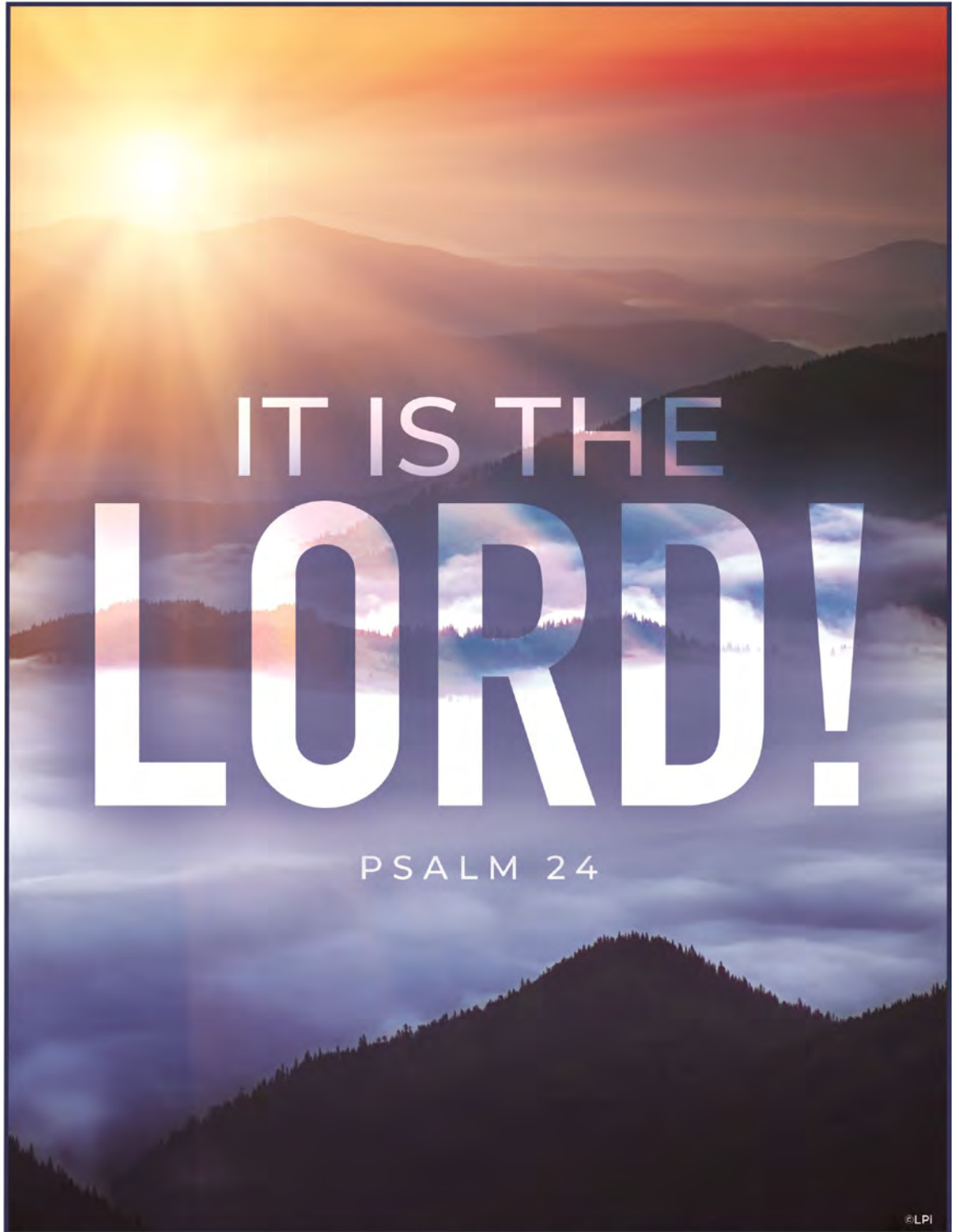

High School: June 22-28 • Knoxville, TN
