

Email Account Note and Public Service Announcement

The perpetrator asks for gift cards for some kind of emergency and the exchange is very convincing. Do not reply to any emails like this; they are fake. And watch the address carefully as it is not from one of my official parish addresses.

As a public service announcement, don't reply to emails that seem to be from your relatives or friends in a crisis situation; this is a common fraud practice that impacts people of all ages, but especially senior citizens, it seems. To verify the situation, always call someone to check if they have truly emailed you asking for help.


