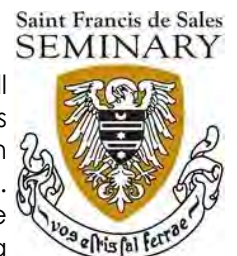

Associate Pastor Transition

We have been blessed with Fr. Joe Jagodenski, SDS, as our shared associate pastor this last year. We knew this would probably be a single year appointment as the Archdiocese needs places for newly ordained priests to start and to be in a parish that still has a rectory. We did, in fact, recently find out that Fr. Joe will return to his religious order for another assignment this summer. I know we are grateful for his presence with us.

At the same time, I am happy to report that the Archbishop has appointed Deacon William Arnold as our associate pastor, starting in mid-June. He will be the shared associate pastor for both parishes, living in the rectory at Christ King, and will be with us at least several years. He will be ordained a priest on May 19 at the Cathedral of Saint John the Evangelist and we should be very excited to welcome the future Fr. Will to our parishes.

As I must return June 2 for another summer of continued canon law studies in Washington, D.C. we will also likely have another priest around to serve as temporary administrator (acting pastor) during the summer. However, Deacon Will and I will plan the summer in advance of my departure, and he will be supported by our capable staff. This is all still being developed.

Below is an introduction from the (soon to be) Father Will Arnold:

"Hello! My name is Deacon, soon to be Father, Will Arnold. Originally from Milwaukee, I grew up in the Enderis Park neighborhood and attended Catholic grade school in Wauwatosa and then high school at Brookfield Academy. In 2012 I graduated from UW-Milwaukee with a bachelor's degree in Criminal Justice. While attending UWM I grew in my faith, committing myself to a prayer regimen, frequent Mass and confession. With the encouragement of a priest-friend, I quietly began discerning the priesthood as I felt the Lord's nudgings and heard His call. I entered St. Francis de Sales Seminary to study to be a priest for the Archdiocese of Milwaukee in August of 2012. After completing six years of seminary formation I, with great joy and excitement, anticipate ordination to the priesthood on May 19th and then look forward to serving as the new associate pastor of Christ King and St. Bernard parishes.



As the fourth child in my family, I have one brother, four sisters and eight nieces and nephews living in the Milwaukee area in addition to my mom and dad. I must confess that I consider myself a bit of a homebody spending free time relaxing by drinking coffee, eating donuts or cookies (usually both) and watching Westerns."

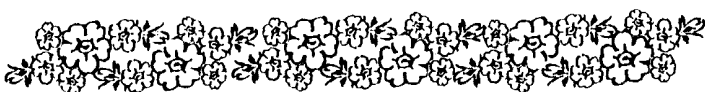

Corporation Board

The parish corporation includes two parishioners on the board of directors, along with the Archbishop, Pastor, and a Vicar General of the Archdiocese. The term of each lay position is two years, renewable.

The pastor may nominate a candidate and Fr. Phillip has nominated Cindy Schmidt to continue in her role for another two-year term. She and her husband Dan have been members of the parish for twenty-seven years. Their children, Joseph and Sarah, are graduates of Christ King School. She has been active in both parish and school ministries for most of her time at Christ King, including numerous school volunteer opportunities, multiple levels of adult leadership with Christ King Girl Scout and Boy Scout troops, coaching, several years on the parish Stewardship Committee, and several terms on the Christ King Parish Council. For the past fourteen years she has written and facilitated Simply the WORD Catholic Scripture Study, which is a multi-parish adult Bible study. In her role as trustee she seeks to actively work with the pastoral staff helping to assist Christ King Parish's move toward answering God's call to live as His missionary disciples.

One who wishes to oppose this nomination in an election must be an active parishioner and call Fr. Phillip at the office to make an appointment to discuss qualifications before May 13.
