Tri-Parish Children's Formation Updates

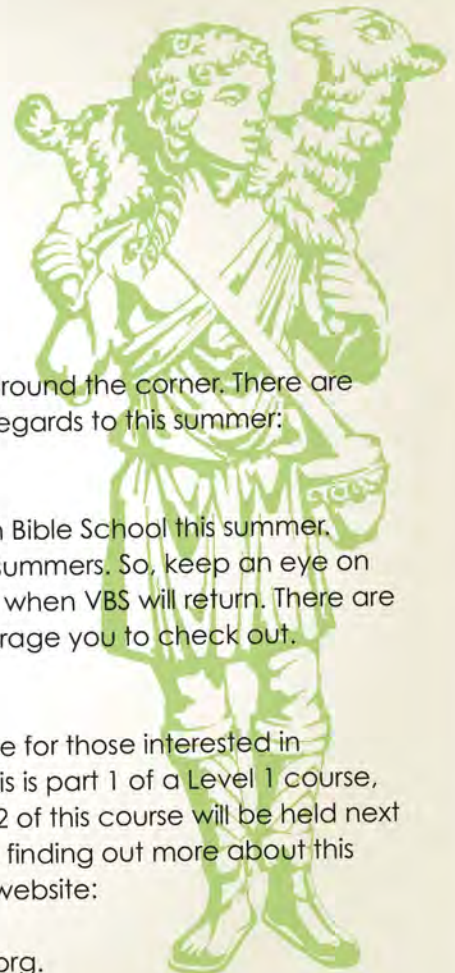
With First Communion celebrations upon us, the summer months are around the corner. There are two things that I would like to take some time to update you on with regards to this summer:
