The parish office will be closed on Memorial Day, Monday, May 28th. We will be open for normal hours on Tuesday, May 29. Have a wonderful holiday!

WHY are we celebrating a special feast AGAIN this weekend? I thought that the Easter season was over!

And NO !!—the Church didn't add these celebrations to our liturgical calendar so that priests can gradually ease into the "wearin' of the green" for the long stretch of Ordinary Time that lies ahead of us!

Every year, on the Sunday after Pentecost, we celebrate Trinity Sunday, (officially "The Solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity") This is one of the few feasts of the Christian Year that celebrates a reality and doctrine rather than an event or person—and it celebrates one of the principle tenets of our faith: our belief in a Triune God!

While this is a special Sunday set aside to commemorate the sacred mystery—the union of Father, Son and Holy Spirit—as we worship together today, take note of how often we articulate our belief in the Trinity. With the Sign of the Cross, the Gloria, the Profession of Faith, the Doxology at the end of the Eucharistic Prayer, and the blessing at the end of Mass—

—with each of these, at ANY Mass or any time we pray, we profess and celebrate our belief in one God in three divine persons.
