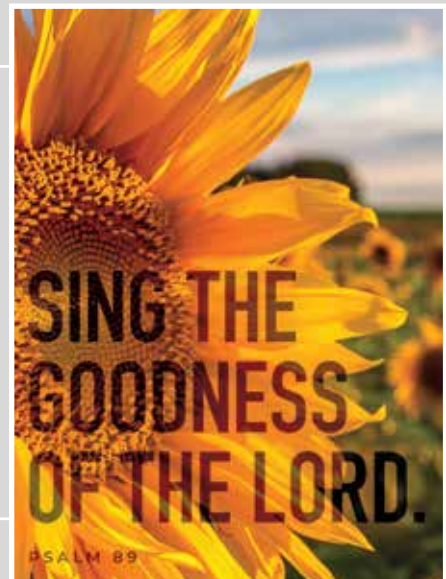

STATUS OF OPERATIONS AT CHRIST KING AND SAINT BERNARD PARISHES

as of June 23, 2020

CELEBRATING MASS AT CHRIST KING AND SAINT BERNARD PARISHES

Daily and Sunday Masses at Christ King and Saint Bernard Parishes are celebrated publicly, with modifications unique to our parishes.

SUNDAY MASSES

- Saturdays: 4:00 p.m. at both Christ King and Saint Bernard
- Sundays: 8:00 a.m. and 10:30 a.m. at both Christ King and Saint Bernard

DAILY MASSES

Daily Masses are celebrated five days/week at various times to meet the differing schedules of individuals. The daily Mass is celebrated at either Christ King or Saint Bernard, depending on the day:

- **Current**
 - Tuesdays: 5:30 p.m. at Saint Bernard
 - Fridays: 12:00 noon at Christ King
- **As of July 6, 2020**
 - Mondays: 8:15 a.m. at Saint Bernard
 - Tuesdays: 5:30 p.m. at Saint Bernard, followed by Sacrament of Reconciliation
 - Wednesdays: 7:00 a.m. at Christ King
 - Thursdays: 8:00 a.m. at Christ King
 - Fridays: 12:00 noon at Christ King

LITURGICAL ADAPTATIONS AS OF SUMMER 2020

- Capacity is limited to 140 at Saint Bernard and 270 at Christ King for all celebrations (25% of capacity). No advance reservation is necessary.
- All are welcome. Mask usage is one's personal choice. Celebrants do not wear masks during celebrations.
- You may enter or exit through any door which is open.
- While hand sanitizer is available, please bring your own hand sanitizer if you wish to use it.
- In order to accommodate different relationships and situations, there are no markings on the floor; you are responsible for keeping sufficient distance from others in seating and movement. Some pews are restricted.
- Liturgical and hospitality ministers are restricted in number to reduce interpersonal contact.
- At the end of Mass, we ask all to leave the church immediately to allow for cleaning. Feel free to visit outside the building.
- The celebrant will not greet congregants before or after Mass. This will return in the future.
- Some liturgical modifications are in place. For example, the Precious Blood is not available to the assembly. The fullness of Jesus Christ is present in the Body and Blood, whether one or both is received. While the Sign of Peace remains, there is no physical sign of peace, in accord with existing liturgical options in the Roman Missal.
- Those who wish to receive the Blessed Sacrament on the tongue are asked to present themselves at the end of the line.
- When possible, doors will be kept open during Mass to allow free air flow. Prepare for warm or cool drafts and temperatures during celebrations.
- Those who are sick or at high risk of contracting or passing on infectious diseases are asked to refrain from attending public celebrations. The Sunday obligation all Catholics hold is legitimately dispensed for an individual who has a well-founded barrier from attending Mass on a Sunday or Holy Day of Obligation.

ADORATION OF THE BLESSED SACRAMENT

- **Current**
 - Tuesdays 12:00 noon - 5:30 p.m. at Saint Bernard
 - Fridays: 6:30 a.m. – 12:00 noon at Christ King (may not occur in the event of funerals or needs related to new parish organ)
- **Beginning July 7**
 - Tuesdays 4:00-8:00 p.m. at Saint Bernard (interrupted for Mass from 5:30-6:00 p.m.)

SACRAMENT OF RECONCILIATION

The priest will depart after the last penitent has completed, so arrive near the start time.

- Saturdays: 9:00 a.m. at Christ King
- Saturdays: 3:00 p.m. at Saint Bernard (ends by 3:40 to prepare for Mass)
- Tuesdays: 6:00 p.m. at Saint Bernard

PERSONAL PRAYER AND REFLECTION

Both Christ King and Saint Bernard are open for personal prayer and reflection Monday through Friday 6:30 a.m. - 8:00 p.m.

FUNERALS

Funeral homes should call one of the parish priests directly (Saint Bernard 414-258-4320 or Christ King 414-258-2604) in the event of a death.

WEDDINGS

Newly engaged couples should contact Director of Liturgy, Maggie Pernice at 414-258-2604 as soon as possible to start the process of marriage preparation and scheduling. The couple will then contact one of the parish priests directly to continue the process. Weddings already scheduled and uncertain of the form of celebration due to COVID-19 should contact the parish priest preparing them to discuss.

BAPTISMS

Baptisms are celebrated on particular Saturdays and Sundays during Mass or after the last Sunday Mass. Contact the Saint Bernard (414-258-4320) or Christ King (414-258-2604) office to start the process in scheduling a baptism. Baptisms are celebrated along with other families desiring a baptism, due to the large number of baptisms at our parishes. Classes are required but may not be currently available due to COVID-19 related changes and restrictions.

ANOINTING OF THE SICK

Contact one of the parish priests as soon as possible to celebrate this sacrament.

PARISH SCHOOLS

Christ King Parish School and Wauwatosa Catholic School plan to operate in person for the 2020-2021 academic year for K3-8th grade formation. Some modifications may occur.
