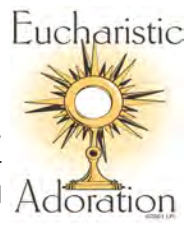

The Prayer Shawl Ministry

The Prayer Shawl Ministry began in St. Louis several years ago, and has spread across the country. Our ministry was introduced to Christ King in 2008 by Z Schaefer who saw the need and value of this ministry.

We currently have twelve active members, meeting the first Wednesday of the month, except for the summer months, in the Parish Library starting at 9:00 a.m. We not only make shawls, but also comfort robes and scarves for men and are given to persons who are seriously ill, have suffered a loss or are in the midst of a crisis. The recipient does not have to be a parish member but are often given to relatives and friends of parishioners. Many of our recipients are taken from the Pray for the Sick List in the bulletin, but a great number are by word of mouth from parish members. We also give age appropriate items to children who are seriously ill. Members pray while they knit or crochet the item, and we pray over them at our meeting. We include a card praying that the recipient will feel the healing, comfort and peace of God's love.

To date, we have given out 309 items. Needs also exist in our greater community. We have given shawls to Zilber Hospice and Froedtert. The women also make preemie baby hats, booties and blankets for Froedtert along with arm sleeves which are worn by dialysis patients during blood transfusions to keep their arm warm. Through the years, countless children's winter hats, scarves and mittens have been given to various agencies for children in need.

New members are welcome at any time and at any skill level of knitting or crocheting, from beginner to advanced. We would also gladly accept donations of yarn. If you know of someone who would be comforted by one of these items, please call Z at (414) 477-0611 or Pat at (414) 771-9189.

As summer slowly starts to wind down, and schedules begin to fill again, be mindful as you mark your calendars. Challenge yourself to carve out time each day to reflect, stop in church during adoration, go to daily Mass, pray. Giving to yourself and being generous to others is our Faith in action.

- Adoration** - Friday, August 3 is First Friday. It is an extended Adoration time. Every First Friday Adoration begins at 6AM until 8AM Mass and then after Mass until 1PM. Here at Christ King we have Adoration every Thursday and Friday from 6-8AM. Mark all the First Fridays on your calendar and take time to come and pray in front of the Lord.
- August 15** - Solemnity of the Assumption of Mary into Heaven - Holy Day of Obligation. What does this mean? Mary, Mother of Jesus, is assumed body and soul into Heaven after her earthly life was done. We celebrate this belief. Find a Mass that day to celebrate Mary.
- Back to School** - It's that time...School supplies are out in stores and schedules are changing. As educators make preparations for the new school year say a prayer not only for them but also for principals, administrators and the students. Pray for a safe and productive school year.
