Our Prayer Garden

Did you know we have a prayer garden here at Christ King? It is a beautiful space nestled between the church and Parish Center, on the Swan Blvd. side of campus, perfect for quiet prayer and meditation.

It was created by PJ Guinen, a Christ King School alumnus, as an Eagle Scout project, helping him earn his Eagle rank in 2011. It had been an open, weedy area of the church grounds before it was cleared and planted with the perennials and bushes that now fill the beds. The Mary statue and benches were also donated to complete the project. The garden was dedicated to the late Katie McNabb, a faith-fulled woman, parishioner, wife, and mother, who had a deep devotion to Mary. She was a model of selflessness for all who knew her.

A few years later, a group of four Christ King School alumnae and Girl Scouts from Troop 1228 continued to rehabilitate the space. They weeded, planted over 100 bulbs, refinished the benches, and built the little library. They purchased and donated Catholic based books and meditations to complete their project, helping them earn their Silver Award in 2014.

If you haven't had a chance to visit, or pray in the garden, this would be a great week to do that! August 15 is the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary, a Holy Day of Obligation, honoring the end of Mary's earthly life and assumption into Heaven. Celebrate the Eucharist in honor of Mary by leaving flowers at her statue.
