## AT THE PARISH

Now is the time to consider sharing the gift of music with our parish community!

The Christ King Adult Choir begins regular rehearsals on Thursday, September 7th from 7:00 pm until 9:00 pm. The rehearsal room is located on the 2nd floor of the Parish Center. You do not need any prior choral experience and an audition isn't required. Come to our first open rehearsal to see if choir could be for you! Energize your faith through singing and friendship!

The Children's Choir begins rehearsals on Wednesday, September 13th from 4:00 pm until 5:00 pm. Information on how to sign-up and a full rehearsal and performance schedule are available on our parish website or through the Christian Formation and School offices. Our Children's Choir is open to any child in grades 3 through 6. This is a great way for kid's to learn about our faith through song and service to our parish community!

The Handbell Choir rehearses on Wednesday Evenings from 6:00 pm until 7:30 pm. This group is comprised of 12 Adults who have basic music reading skills. This choir will ring at two Masses monthly. This ministry is our most flexible music ministry—rehearsal time etc is scheduled directly with the Director of Liturgical Music as needed.
