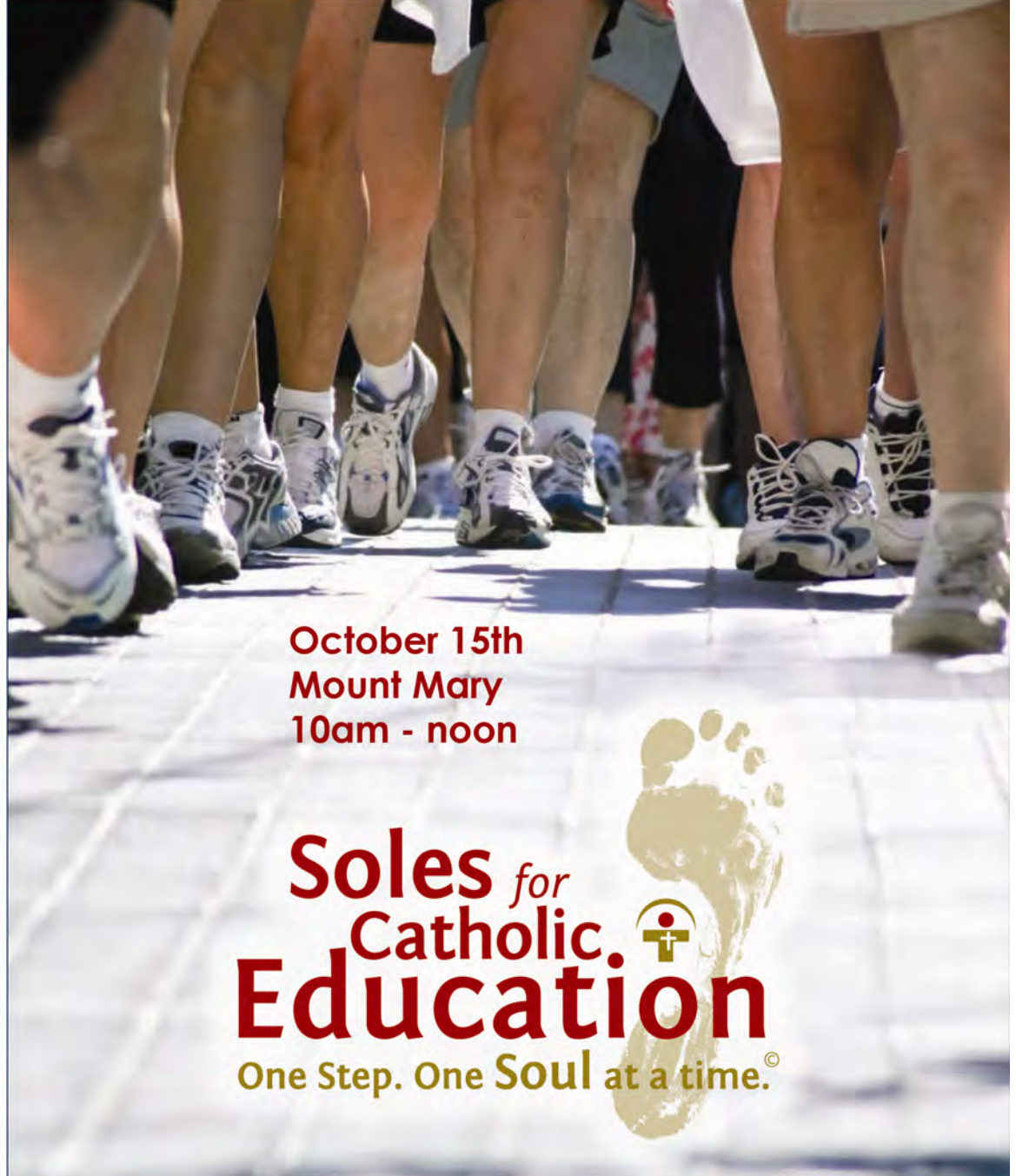

Jesus: A Pilgrimage by James Martin, S.J.

This unique biography of Christ traces Jesus's time on earth as Father Martin visits Holy Land locations mentioned in the New Testament. Readers see incidents such as the Miracle of the Loaves and Fishes, the Raising of Lazarus, the Meeting with Zacchaeus, and the events during and after Holy Week as they might have if they witnessed the events firsthand. One reviewer writes: “James Martin’s riveting meditation on Jesus is one of the best books I’ve read in years—on any subject. Part memoir, part historical document, part spiritual retreat, and part travelogue, *Jesus* is a love letter to the first-century Jewish radical. Martin has devoted his life to following. 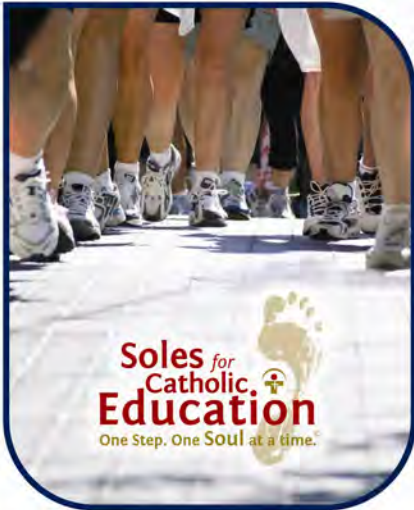
