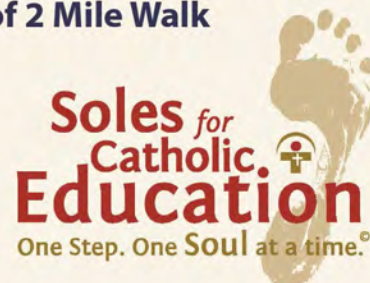

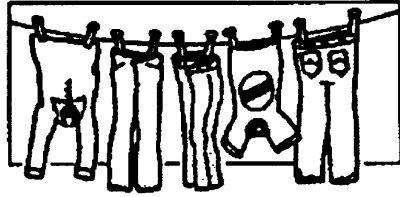

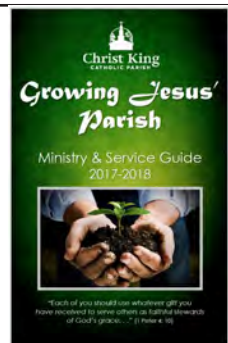
Clothing Drive

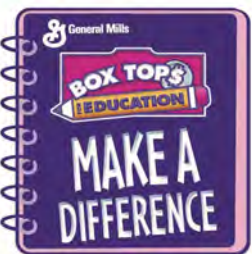

Last week, our middle school students in both our day school and Faith Formation program received an information packet on how to become an altar server here at Christ King. We're excited about offering this service opportunity once again. Talk to your student and find out if there is an interest and desire to serve the parish in this very special and rewarding manner.

Over the past few years, we have found offering two focused and intense sessions in the fall provides us the ability to ease our students into the server rotations within a few

weeks after completion. Each session is in a small group setting (6 students per session maximum). We offer four different day and time options for both the First and Second Sessions to allow for flexibility around your family's schedule. We ask that your student make a 1st, 2nd and 3rd choice for each of the two sessions.

Archbishop Listecky's Annual Pallium Lecture; "Beyond Career to Calling"




