



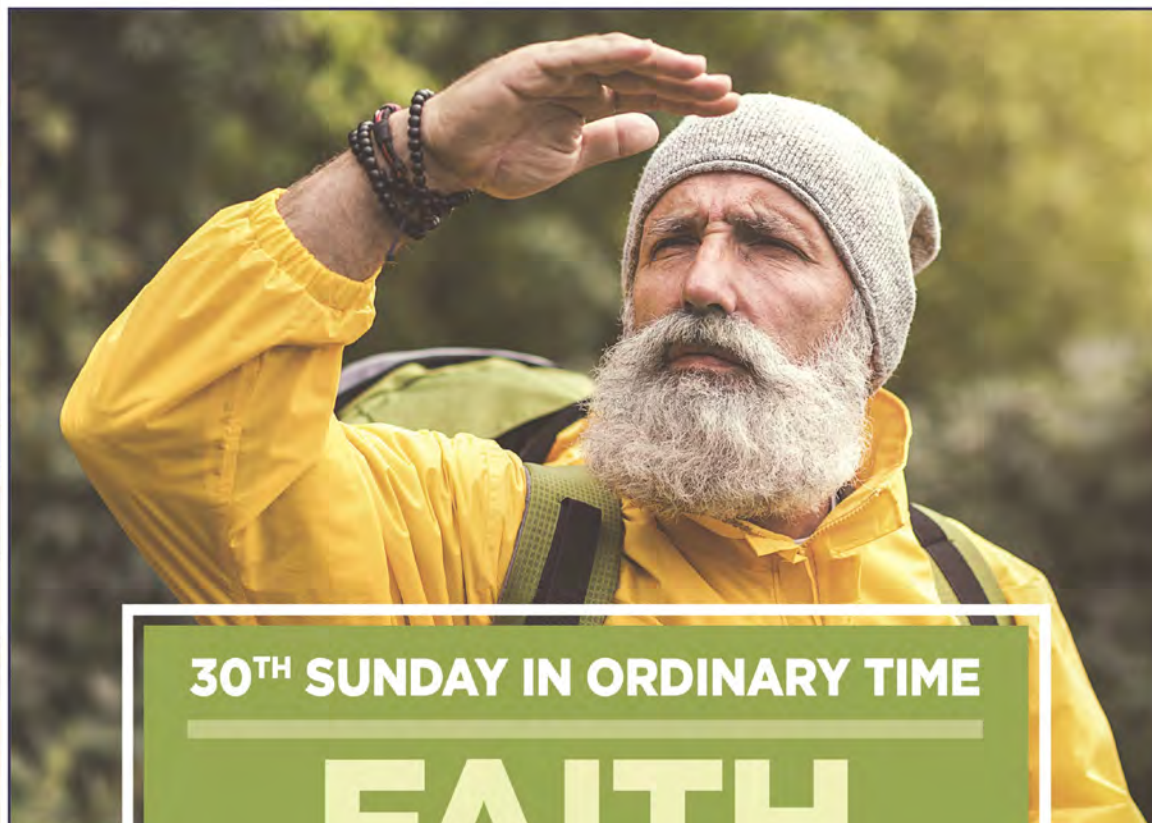

Join us as we begin a 33-day preparation for Marian Consecration beginning **November 5th and ending on December 8th** - the feast of the Immaculate Conception.


