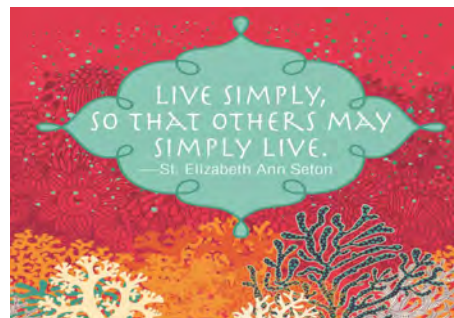

And thanks to **Bill Lieven**, who connected us to the divine with amazing sacred music. His leadership and execution is what generated so much conversation after all the Masses. I am so proud both of them are key parts of our parish staff.

They were assisted by many volunteers, liturgical ministers, music ministers, our choirs, and instrumentalists. Thanks to some individuals who gave their special vocal and musical talents to enhance our celebrations. There are too many to adequately mention by name.

And many of you stepped forward to donate to give away the Christmas book once again. People really appreciate this gesture and it plants important seeds. We could use a few more dollars, so your targeted donation is welcome to cover the cost of the books and not impact the budget.
