Dear Friends,

Just a few months ago, we launched the “Living the Call, Sharing God’s Gifts” capital appeal. It has been over ten years since our last appeal, so this is a rare and needed moment in our parish.

The projects are comprehensive, designed to address a broad array of significant challenges to maintain a healthy parish. The needs touch not only aging infrastructure, but the demand to more powerfully evangelize, and to reach out to those in need.

Our goals were set aggressively, with the hope of eliminating the need for more small appeals in the next years, and forcing ourselves to place our complete trust in the Holy Spirit. With that challenge, we currently find ourselves in a uniquely positive position.

A significant percentage of parishioners quickly surpassed our “Celebration” goal of \$3.5 million, and we are close to our “Challenge” goal of \$4.5 million. There is new enthusiasm to reach the finish line, the “Transformation” goal of \$6 million. This final goal is exciting, but it is also a big step.

As a friend of the parish, I’m requesting your prayers and financial support as we make our final push to the transformational goal. If we reach this point, our parish will eliminate all debt, and significant funds will be redirected to a salary increase for our teachers and staff.

At a difficult moment in the life of the Church, we are making a commitment to deeper, more authentic prayer, holiness, and discipleship, to create a better future for those who are in need, today, and for those who will come after us.

OUR PROGRESS



Our "Transformation" goal of \$6 million, \$1.5 million above our "Challenge" goal, will allow us to pay off our existing loan thereby freeing up resources for improved pay and expansion of parish staff, while designating another 5% to outreach.



\$4.3M (AS OF 12/14/18)

We have reached 80% of our "Challenge" goal, nearing almost a million dollars above the \$3.5 million "Celebration" goal. We can now look forward to most of the items from this goal list: replacing broken

school windows and doors; enhancing safety and exterior lighting; other urgent campus maintenance needs; contributing to our capital improvement endowment fund; and allocating 5% to outreach.



REACHED! With the "Celebration" goal of \$3.5 million met, we will be replacing the campus boiler and HVAC systems which are near failure; enhancing the lighting efficiency and aesthetics in our church; replacing our organ which is near failure; improving school spaces; renovating space and securing new materials for religious education's transition to Catechesis of the Good Shepherd; replacing the parking lot and fence to improve functionality and safety; completing major roof repairs; and allocating 5% to outreach.

SEE PROJECT PROGRESS ON BACK

- Work has begun on the Church file roofing repair and copper gutter replacement, as well as addressing and repairing active leaks related to the school roofing.



- A professional lighting design service has been engaged to provide proposals for the interior Church and exterior campus lighting upgrades.
- The Parking Lot & Fence Committee has developed a Request for Proposal to secure a firm to provide assistance with the design and implementation of the project.
- A boiler assessment has been completed and it has been determined the failing boilers will need to be replaced. Options for two new boilers are being investigated.
- A structural engineering evaluation is being conducted this month to determine the location for a new energy and environmentally friendly Church air conditioning unit.
- Due diligence for many of the school updates is in progress. This includes underwriting and project management of the wireless infrastructure upgrade, installation of new water fountains with filling stations, options for new classroom flooring, new lunch tables and an improved sound system for the gym.
- The organ is being built and should arrive in December, 2020. Planning and design to reconfigure and construct the space for it is in progress.
