

CAPITAL APPEAL UPDATES



In late 2018, the parish embarked on an ambitious three year capital appeal, with a goal of raising six million dollars to help address many exterior and interior campus building needs as well as to pay-off existing debt, freeing up resources for; expanded financial reserves for long-term growth and stability, staff salary increases, and expanded outreach to the poor and needy.

Now in our second year, parishioners and friends of the parish have pledged more than \$4.7 million, allowing us to move forward on all building maintenance needs.

A number of projects were finalized over summer, and a few are currently in process:

School Updates

Old worn out and stained classroom carpeting was removed, cement repaired, and beautiful, durable and easy-to-clean laminate flooring was installed.

New classroom window balances were installed providing effortless opening and closing.

The newly enhanced and robust wireless network enables effective use of technology, like the new faster laptops that all school staff received this summer, complimenting the smart boards, screens and new student chrome books purchased last year.

The final parking lot asphalt layer and striping were completed this summer, as well as the newly expanded play structure.
