ADULT CHOIR

- Twice weekly rehearsals: Thursdays 6:30-7:30 pm and Sundays 9:15-10:15 am in the choir loft
- Sings 3/4 times a month at the Sunday 10:30 am Mass
- First rehearsal: Thursday September 3, with the first Mass being the 10:30 am Mass on Sunday the 6th
- Ability to read musical notation, while a plus, is not required
- Interested new (and returning) members should reach out to Evan via email or phone



BELL CHOIR

- Weekly rehearsals: Wednesdays 5:15-6:30 pm in the back of the nave
- Rings once a month, typically at the Sunday 8 am Mass.
- First rehearsal: Wednesday September 9
- Basic music-reading ability required, although experience with bell ringing is not.

CHILDREN'S CHOIR

- Open to any child in grades, 3-6
- Weekly Rehearsals: Wednesdays 2-3:00 pm
- Sings once a month at a Sunday Mass and occasionally at School Mass on Thursdays.
- First rehearsal: Wednesday September 9, with the first Mass being the 10:30 am Mass on the 27th.
