3rd grade Girls Group wrapped packages of diapers & hats for the Women's Care Center.



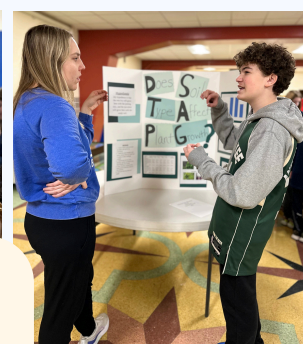

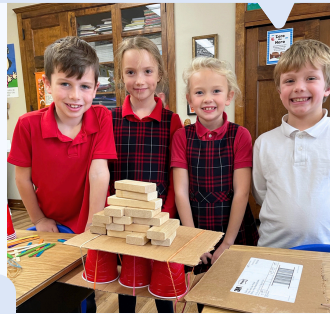
FIRST-FIFTH GRADE ELEMENTARY
