Dear Families of Christ King Parish School,

Thank you for committing to our community of discipleship at Christ King Parish School. Please read this tuition contract carefully. It clarifies the benefits and expectations of families who entrust their students to the care of our parish school.

**"What Do I Get?"**

Christ King Parish School commits to providing a faith-based education to your children. We know our students, we love our students, and we prepare them for high school and heaven.

**"What Do I Give?"**

We hope you will feel called to give sacrificially, offering your time, talent, and treasure in ways that make a difference to your family. Some people tell us they don't know where to start, though, so consider a minimum contribution in the following areas (there is no maximum!):

- **Time:** Several hours a month--this might come in the form of planning and working at one major parish or school event and helping with 10-20 smaller opportunities (about 1-2 a month), such as recess duty, hospitality at weekend Mass, field trip supervision, etc.
- **Talent:** You are a gift! Please communicate with Terri Hawk and the Parent Engagement committee to discern where your particular strengths might shine in areas needed by the parish and school.
- **Treasure:** Since tuition covers only a fraction of what it really costs to operate the school, the parish relies on consistent stewardship—above and beyond the cost of tuition—to subsidize the education your students enjoy. Scripture recommends a tithe (10% of income). Donating to the parish should be a financial priority for each family, a critical monthly line item in the family budget.

**"Do I Belong?"**

Christ King Parish School nurtures our children's growth in the Catholic faith by teaching them to accept and respect Jesus in everyone they meet within an environment that cultivates academic excellence, encourages service to others, fosters leadership, and allows all students to develop their God-given talents. That mission promises spiritual, academic, and personal growth in a Christian community. This community includes you. Your own spiritual growth is a priority, and we welcome you to participate in at-home prayer, small group opportunities in the parish and school, and large group events. Most importantly, attending Mass every weekend helps us all belong to God and one another.

**"How Can We Grow?"**

Check out our current parish and school offerings (on the attached page) and commit to at least two opportunities. Pay attention to how you and your family members grow as you embrace spiritual, social, and educational moments at home and in the parish community. The Lord is king; let the earth rejoice!

**TUITION AGREEMENT 2023-2024**  
**Christ King Parish School - Wauwatosa WI**

I ask that my children be enrolled at Christ King Parish School for the 2023-2024 school year. I elect to send my children to Christ King Parish School because I want them to receive a Catholic education. The school is part of the spiritual mission of the parish. I accept my responsibility as a school parent to my children and the parish community, and I agree to the following:

- To live and practice my Catholic faith. This includes registering as a Christ King Parish member before the school year begins and fulfilling my responsibility to attend Mass every Sunday and Holy Day of Obligation.
- To teach my children through word and example to live their Catholic faith.
- To adhere to all the policies and procedures in the Christ King Catholic Parish School Handbook.
- Aware that tuition is a small portion of the resources necessary to operate the school, I will actively support the parish by giving my time, talent, and treasure in parish stewardship.

(1) This tuition amount is a request. Families who are active members of Christ King Parish and faithful to the agreement above may request the reduced tuition rate. Those choosing not to meet the expectations of their request may experience a tuition adjustment.

**Financial Assistance:** Families requesting financial assistance must complete the application form available on the Christ King website or at the parish office. Electronic enrollment through Blackbaud is required even if requesting financial assistance. The financial assistance form must be submitted by June 23, 2023, to be considered.

**Tuition Refunds:** As staffing decisions have been made for your child, a tuition refund will be made only if requested during the first ten school days of the current school year. Students transferring from Christ King after the first ten days for any reason are responsible for the full-year tuition.

**Payment Options:** Tuition can be paid in installments. Interest is not charged. All payments, regardless of the plan chosen, are accepted electronically through the Blackbaud platform, not to Christ King. Any checks received will be returned. A \$40.00 fee will be assessed for each electronic payment that is past due or returned for non-sufficient funds (NSF).

Option 1 - One-time payment due on or before July 31, 2023

Option 2 - Bi-Annual payment plan. Payments are evenly divided in two installments: July 31, 2023, and January 31, 2024

Option 3 - 11 Month payment plan. Payments are evenly divided over 11 consecutive months, processed on the twenty-fifth of each month. Payments will begin July 25, 2023, and end May 25, 2024.
